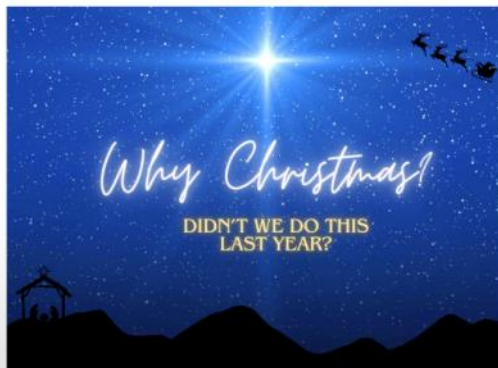
Christmas Postcards
