Banksia Markets - Positions Vacant


Saturday Market Manager (2 Volunteers as a shared role would be ideal)

Know what items go in which bin to help reduce the amount of waste, we as a church are sending to landfill.

Green lid - Organics

Coffee cups and lids, coffee grounds and tea bags, hand towels and tissues, compostable plates and

bowls, food scraps, garden waste, shredded paper, cardboard and pizza boxes.



Paper, junk mail, milk and juice cartons (lids off), glass bottles and jars (lids off), empty aerosol cans, egg cartons. Plastic lids go into an empty bottle all together.

Red lid - General waste

All other general waste such as plastics, nappies and disposable items.
