NEW SONG FOR MAY - I Will Fear No More, The Afters

"Fear No More" by The Afters is a faith-filled anthem that addresses anxiety and uncertainty with trust in God. The song honestly captures the weight of fear, using relatable imagery to describe feeling overwhelmed in difficult moments. As it unfolds, the focus shifts from fear to faith. The chorus declares a choice to trust God's control and protection, even in life's storms. Repeated affirmations of "I will fear no more" reinforce courage rooted not in self-strength, but in God's presence.

The bridge proclaims victory over fear, reminding listeners that the battle has already been won. Through themes of hope, resilience and faith, "Fear No More" encourages believers to face uncertainty with confidence and peace.

Isaiah 41:10 *Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.*

Philippians 4:6 *Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.*

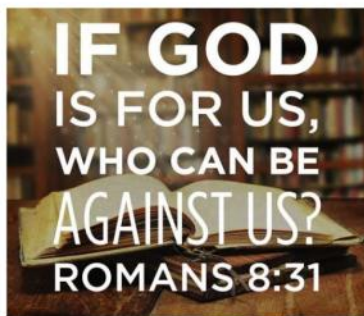
