# Overview Of Acts

Acts of the Apostles records the growth of the early church after Jesus' resurrection and ascension. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, believers spread the gospel from Jerusalem to the wider Roman world demonstrating God's power through preaching, fellowship, prayer, generosity and courageous witness.

## Key Purposes for the Church in Acts

- Proclaim the good news of Jesus.
- Depend on the Holy Spirit for guidance and power.
- Devote themselves to prayer and worship.
- Build an authentic and caring community.
- Make disciples and equip believers.
- Serve others with generosity and compassion.
- Reach across cultural and social barriers.
- Remain faithful in the face of opposition.
