NEW SONG FOR SEPTEMBER

Everything with Breath, by Alexander Pappas

A joyful call to worship inspired by Psalm 150: "Let everything that has breath praise the Lord." The song reminds us that praise is not simply something we do—it is what we were created for.

The song is as an invitation to move beyond our comfort zones and into wholehearted praise. Drawing on examples throughout Scripture, the song celebrates the power of praise to strengthen faith, bring freedom, and fill God's people with joy. When we gather to worship, God is there, when we recognise that the Lord of all creation is in our midst, our natural response is to worship. Through singing, shouting, and lives surrendered to Him. The song encourages believers of every generation to express their praise boldly and joyfully, trusting that breakthrough and renewed faith are often found on the other side of worship.

As we sing Everything With Breath together, may we be reminded that every breath is a gift from God and an opportunity to give Him the praise He deserves.
