Following our recent Congregational Meeting, where all three proposals were approved, Church Council discussed the next steps for each proposal:

- Pastor – Youth, Young Adults and Night Service: Progressing the process of advertising and appointing this new position.
- New Toilet Facilities: Beginning the process of planning and considering the next steps for these facilities. A committee is being formed to progress this proposal, with Sheila convening the committee.
- Shared Ministry with Lighthouse Church: Discussed the practical arrangements for Roger's shared ministry between the two churches, including his oversight of a new children's ministry worker at Lighthouse Church.
